STUDYING THEOLOGY

at the *Grand Séminaire de l'Archidiocèse de Montréal (GSAM)*

The **GSAM** offers **Theology courses in English** to English-speaking students including lay and consecrated people, members of religious communities and candidates to the permanent diaconate from dioceses in Quebec and Canada.

Theological studies may be undertaken at the GSAM to earn a **Certificate in Theology** or in **Continuing Education**.

Our **teaching body** comprises lay, consecrated and religious people as well as priests. We are blessed to count on the dedication of professors who believe in our mission and possess solid academic backgrounds and teaching experiences from Catholic Universities and Institutes in Québec, Canada, and internationally.

Teaching formats

Courses are available in the following teaching formats:

- **Comodal:** lectures are given in person at the GSAM, 6895 rue Boyer, Montréal. Students can attend in person or online.
- **Online:** lectures are given and attended online only.

Learning paths

Students may study theology for :

- to earn a **Certificate in Theology** from Université Laval.
- in **Continuing Education**, without university credits and degree. Students attend the same lectures as University students. Evaluations are required only if an attestation is requested.

The focus of this course is *Jesus-Christ, Saviour and Redeemer*. Fr. Louis is a seasoned and well-known professor of theology and philosophy, who has taught at Catholic universities across North American. His writings are published in several languages.

CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGY

The Certificate in Theology is offered in partnership with the *Faculté de Théologie et de Sciences Religieuses de l'Université Laval* (FTRSR). Students may enroll in the program with the FTRSR and earn their degree whilst studying Theology in English at the GSAM.

The program is intended for students preparing for a Church ministry or service or those wishing to deepen their understanding of their faith. It is a requirement for candidates to the permanent diaconate for the Archdiocese of Montreal.

The Certificate in Theology comprises 30 credits :

→ 18 credits from **6 required courses**

→ 12 credits from **additional courses**

The GSAM's course offering in English comprises the 6 required courses and 6 additional courses, offered over a 3-year cycle.
